OVERSIZE/OVERWEIGHT PERMIT INFORMATION SHEET

Under Wisconsin Statute 348.27(9m)(a)4., and as defined in 348.01(2)(bt), the Department may issue permits to allow the transportation of “Raw forest products” (which) means logs, pilings, posts, poles, cordwood products, wood chips, sawdust, pulpwood, intermediary lumber, fuel wood and Christmas trees not altered by a manufacturing process off the land, sawmill or factory from which they are taken.

Fruits and vegetables are not eligible commodities under this permit. The Department considers intermediary lumber to be rough-cut lumber that is cut to length but not planed or dried.

- ✓This permit is issued for overweight only, not oversize.
- ✓Only vehicle combinations are valid for movement under this permit.
- ✓This is a divisible load permit.

LIMITATIONS

Vehicles & Loads

Truck/Trailer vehicle combination Length	65' (legal)
Semi-tractor/Trailer combination length on state trunk highways	75' (legal)
Overall Width	8'6" (legal)
Overall Height	13'6" (legal)

WEIGHT
LIMITATIONS

✓This permit allows vehicle combinations with six or more axles to exceed the weight authorized by Wisconsin Statute 348.15(3)(c) by not more than 18,000 pounds.

✓The maximum gross weight authorized per Wisconsin Statute 348.27(9m)(a) and (b) is 98,000 pounds.

Steer Axle	13,000 or manufacturers rated capacity, not to exceed 18,000 lbs.
Any other axle	18,000 lbs
Maximum Permit Weight	98,000 lbs

**ROUTE
LIMITATIONS**

- ✓This permit is not valid for operation on any Interstate highway.
- ✓This permit is not valid on any highway or bridge with a posted weight limitation that is less than the vehicle combination's gross weight.
- ✓This permit is not valid on any part of the state trunk highway system that the department has designated by rule as a route on which a permit issued under this subsection is not valid.

**PERMIT
CONDITIONS**

- ✓Vehicles may be operated at the posted speed limit.
- ✓Vehicles which are overweight only may operate 24 hours a day, including weekends and holidays.
- ✓This permit is not suspended during, the annual spring thaw period.

**INSURANCE
REQUIRED**

Bodily injury, each person \$150,000 or \$750,000
 Bodily injury, each accident \$450,000 combined single
 Property damage, each accident \$300,000 limit

**VEHICLE
REGISTRATION**

- ✓Vehicle or vehicles must be registered for not less than the maximum registration weight available or the permit weight, whichever is less.

**PERMIT
APPLICATION**

- ✓Apply using Multiple Trip Form MV2612.
- ✓Permits may be issued for 3 to 12 months.

**FEE
INFORMATION**

- ✓Submit the required fee, per the table below, with your application. Make checks payable to: **Registration Fee Trust**.
- ✓Calculate fees from the effective DAY of the permit, not the calendar months. (example: 9/5 to 11/20--greater than 2 months to the day, but less than 3 months--would be 3 months.)
