- **Enter the temporary Plate number without dashes**
- **Enter VIN and vehicle model year**

- **Enter complete owner name and address**

Next: Select this button to submit the data to the system. You will return to the Main Menu.

Return to Main Menu: Select this button to cancel and return to the menu.

TEMPORARY PLATE EXPIRATION PERIODS:

90-Day: Temporary Plates are normally valid for 90 days or until the applicant receives the regular registration plates, whichever comes first.

30-Day: Non-residents who purchase or lease a vehicle in Wisconsin are issued a Temporary Plate valid for 30 days.

Lost or mutilated Temporary Plates: Issue a free replacement plate with the same expiration as the lost plate.

Expired Temporary Plates: Issue a free 30-day replacement plate.
