5. If the vehicle that you wish to register with LIF plates is already titled in your name, send:

 - * \$15.00 issuance or personalized plate fee, \$25.00 LIF donation, plus the annual registration fee if the current plates expire within the next 3 months.

6. If the vehicle is NOT titled in your name, send:
- * A completed title application (MV1 or MV11) and fees, including annual registration fee;
 - * Additional \$15.00 issuance or personalized plate fee and \$25.00 LIF donation.

How to Apply

- To order nonpersonalized LIF plates, mark application and omit steps 2-4.
- To order personalized LIF plates, choose 1-6 characters. If you choose 6 characters, no spaces are allowed.

If you choose 5 characters, you may request up to 2 spaces between any of the characters. Indicate spaces with diagonal lines.

- Use capital letters or numbers. The letter O and the number zero are the same. The following are not acceptable: small letters, symbols, signs, hyphens, apostrophes, etc. Carefully distinguish between:

Letter G and Number 6	Letter U and Letter V

INFORMATION

When you request a Donate Life Wisconsin (LIF) plate you pay:

- ◆ A \$15 original issuance fee, or an **annual** \$15 personalized plate fee; (See below.)
- ◆ A \$25 donation, which is sent to Donate Life Wisconsin.
- ◆ Your regular registration fee, if your current plates expire within 3 months.

Thereafter, you will pay the \$25 donation and the regular registration fee for standard LIF plates. The \$25 donation may be deductible if you itemize your income tax returns.

Personalized LIF Plate Available

A \$15 personalized plate fee is required every year in addition to the \$25 donation and regular registration fee.

If your personalized request is not available, check which option on the form you would like us to follow.

WIDOT may refuse to issue OR may recall after issuance, a request that is misleading or may be offensive to good taste or decency.

No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after the plate has been ordered, or if the application is unclear or incorrectly completed.

Plates will be mailed 4-6 weeks after you receive the new Certificate of Registration.

Plates Required in 2 days

To legally operate your vehicle, you must display license plates within 2 business days of purchase. If you do not have current plates, apply to a DMV Customer Service Center or an agent authorized by DMV to obtain a temporary plate while your order is processed. An agent may also charge a \$3 plate fee and/or may charge a \$5 service fee.

Transplantation holds the promise of life for thousands with life-threatening conditions and diseases. The generosity of donor families, who at a time of great tragedy decide to help others, is immeasurable. However, the number of patients waiting increases daily.

- ◆ More than 1,400 are on the waiting list in Wisconsin. Almost 100,000 in the U.S.
- ◆ Every 13 minutes a new name is added to the list.
- ◆ More than 29,000 organ, 46,000 eye and 750,000 tissue transplants are performed each year in the U.S.
- ◆ One of every twenty in the U.S. will undergo a procedure that uses donated tissue.
- ◆ A single tissue donor can help 50-75 people.
- ◆ More than 7,400 families donated their loved one's organs in 2007.

- ◆ Motor Home (Annual registration only);
- ◆ Truck:
 - ◆ 4,500, 6,000 or 8,000 pound gross weight including dual purpose farm and dual purpose motor home;
 - ◆ 12,000 pound gross weight farm truck.
