## US 151 (American Parkway to Main Street)

### Project overview

In order to maintain a safe and efficient transportation system, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing US 151 as three lanes in each direction from American Parkway to Main Street in Sun Prairie. A new interchange is being constructed at the intersection of US 151 and County C/Reiner Road. County C/Reiner Road is also being reconstructed from O'Keeffe Boulevard to just west of Hoepker Road.

Construction began in May 2005. The new structure at US 151 and County C, new northbound lanes on US 151, and the two ramps on the northbound side of US 151 will be completed by December 2005. The remaining work on the southbound lanes will resume in spring 2006, with completion by fall 2006.

For the majority of construction, there are two 11-foot lanes of US 151 traffic in each direction, however, lane closures are required at times. Travelers are encouraged to find alternate routes to ease congestion. WisDOT reminds all drivers to practice safe driving in work zones, including slowing down and staying alert to changing traffic conditions.

The US 151 reconstruction project represents an estimated \$16.8 million investment in Wisconsin's transportation system.

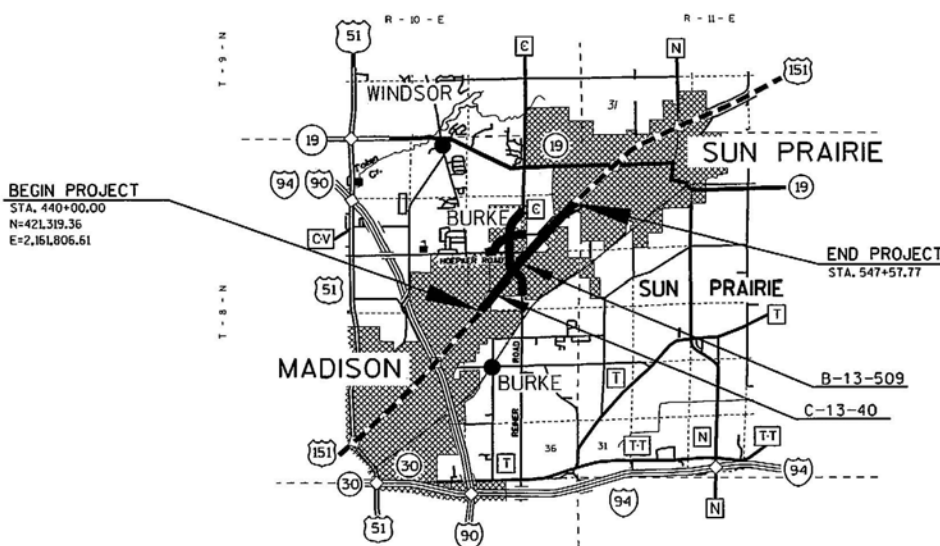
