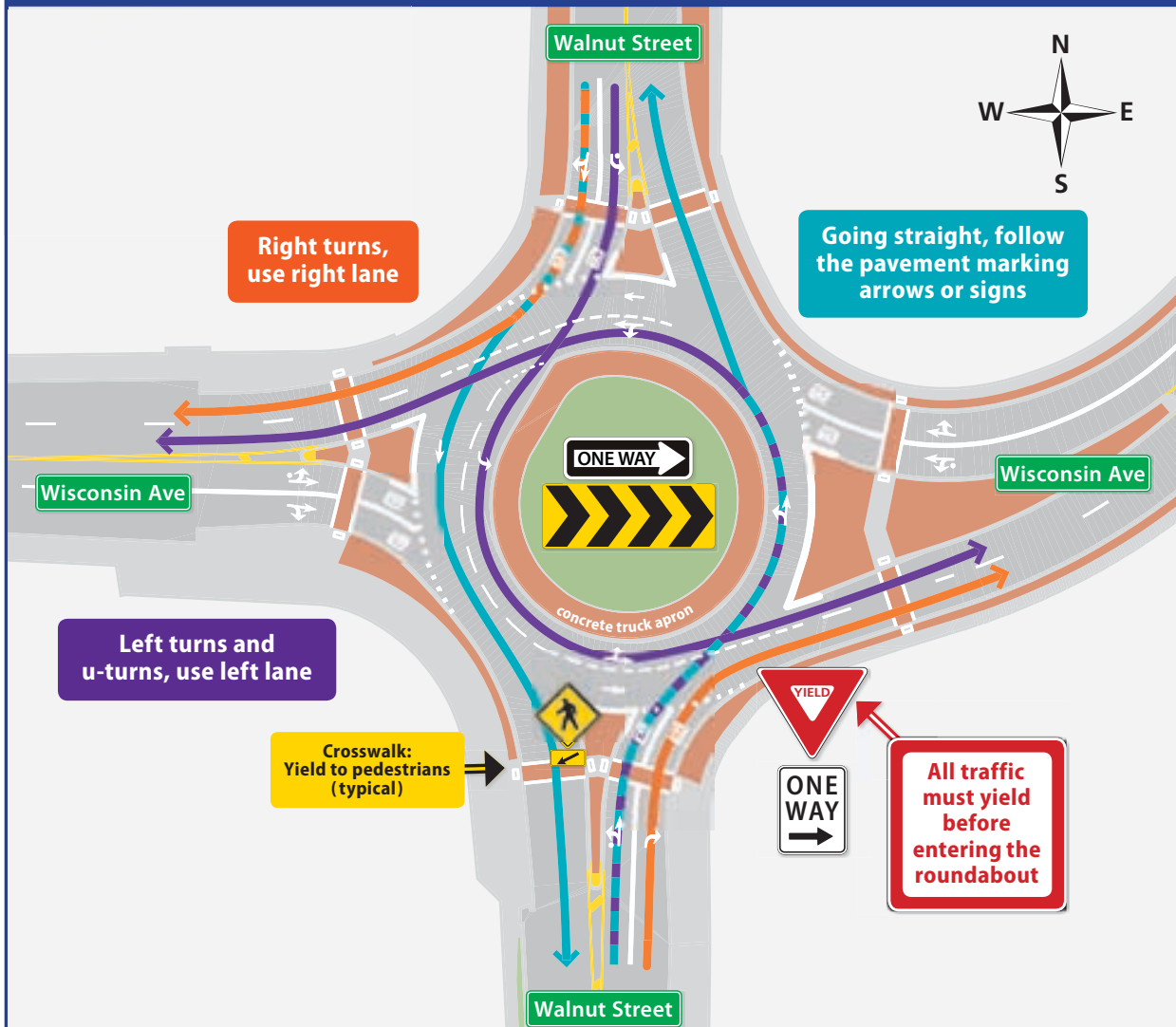




Driving the Oconomowoc Multi-lane Roundabout at Walnut St and Wisconsin Ave



Choose your lane and yield to all traffic before entering roundabout!

Driving a roundabout

1. Slow down as you approach the roundabout.
2. **Choose the correct lane for your desired destination before reaching the yield line.**
3. Yield to traffic already in the roundabout.
4. Wait for a safe gap in traffic before entering.
5. Once in the roundabout you have the right-of-way.
6. Stay in your lane as you circulate.
7. Use your right turn signal to indicate your intention to exit.
8. **Do not change lanes!**

Large vehicles

Large vehicles use the circulating lanes and the colored concrete truck apron that borders the inside of the roundabout.

Drivers should be cautious and never drive adjacent to or pass large trucks while approaching and maneuvering through the roundabout.

Emergency vehicles

Always yield to emergency vehicles.

If you have not entered the roundabout, pull over to the right allowing emergency vehicles to pass.

If you have entered the roundabout, *continue to your exit*, then pull over to the right allowing emergency vehicles to pass.

Never stop in the roundabout.
