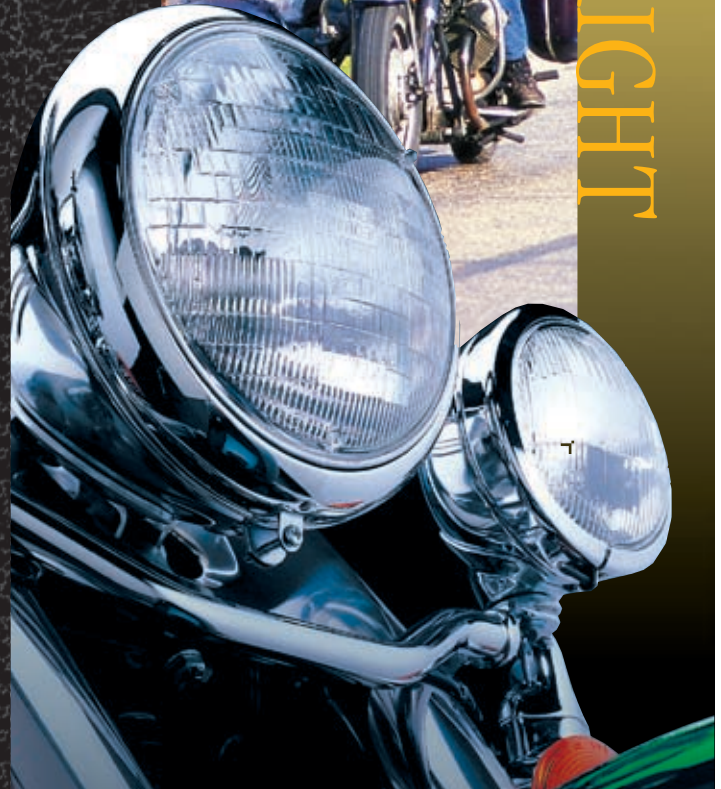

RIDE THE RUSTIC BACK ROADS



The Rustic Roads Motorcycle Tour is a unique program offered by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for people who enjoy riding the back roads of Wisconsin.

The program offers a patch and a certificate to help riders mark their progress in seeing the rustic beauty of the less traveled roads.

AT PRESENT, THERE ARE 107 MARKED RUSTIC ROADS COVERING 604 MILES IN 56 COUNTIES.

RUSTIC ROADS FEATURE NATURAL BEAUTY

You'll see outstanding natural sights on Rustic Roads, features that set them apart from other roads.

- Rugged terrain
- Native vegetation
- Native wildlife
- Open areas with unique agricultural vistas

GET AWAY FROM THE BUSY HIGHWAYS

Rustic Roads are lightly traveled, rural roads with a minimum length of two miles. They are used by both travelers and local residents. Where feasible, a Rustic Road offers a completed loop or connects to a major highway at each end of the route.

- It may be a dirt, sand, gravel or paved road.
- Some unpaved roads may not be recommended under certain conditions.
- Roads may be one way or two way.
- The maximum speed limit is 45 miles per hour.

HERE'S HOW TO GET YOUR PATCH AND CERTIFICATE

You need to travel at least 10 of the Rustic Roads for a patch and 25 or more of the roads for a certificate.

To verify participation, have your picture taken with your bike in front of the Rustic Road numbered sign. If solo, just your bike needs to be in front of the numbered sign. Once you assemble the minimum number of photos (10 or 25), forward them to the Wisconsin Motorcycle Safety Program for a patch and/or certificate. There is no time limit, and group photos are acceptable.
